Dear Customer,

The EU REACH regulation 2018/1513 regulates at EU level substances produced or imported into the European Union in quantities equal to or greater than one ton per year and provides for their registration, evaluation, authorization and restriction.

Entered into force on 1st June 2007, the REACH Regulation had a new phase on 1st June 2008 with expiration on 1st December 2008, a period in which the Companies that introduce chemical substances into the European Union have pre-registered these substances with the 'ECHA, European Chemical Agency.

The plastic materials (polymers) used for molding are not subject to the obligation of registration and evaluation and neither are the articles obtained from polymer molding as during the transformation phase (molding) from polymer to finished article there is no release intentional of chemicals and there is no modification of the polymer. Even the metal inserts in steel, brass, aluminum, zamak are currently considered non-releasing substances and therefore are not subject to registration.

It follows that STATER being a processing company, does not use or produce dangerous substances and therefore the articles produced do not need to be pre-registered or registered.

In order to protect its customers, since 2008 STATER has asked for clarification from all its suppliers and has received extensive written assurances that all products supplied to STATER are compliant or not subject to the REACH Regulation.

The aforementioned Suppliers are also obliged to inform STATER of any possible variation or loss of validity of the products to the REACH Regulation as a result of amendments to the regulation itself.

To date, the suppliers have assured us that the substances mentioned in the Candidate List (SVHC) are not contained in polymers (see last update of January 19, 2021).
